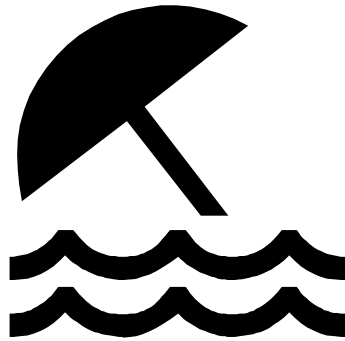

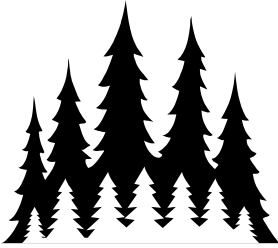

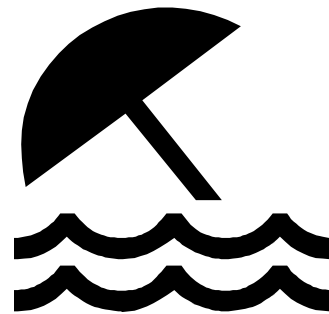
Recreation and the Snack Bar will be minimally staffed the last week of August. Over the Labor Day weekend we are fully operational.

BLSHA 2008 Rules and Fee Schedule

Please review the rules and fee schedule and remember that there is a fee to replace all lost or damaged membership or guest cards. **Everyone must check in at the Recreation Office window and be prepared to show your membership card along with photo ID.** (*Ask to be "stamped" when leaving the facility for easy re-entry if returning the same day*)

Membership:

In accordance with the By-laws, one set of membership cards are issued per lot. Two membership cards and one guest card are issued. Membership privileges extend only to immediate family; a members spouse and dependent offspring.

Members with Guests:

A membership is entitled to accompany six guests to the facility without charge. The member may accompany additional guests for a guest fee of \$4.00 per person.

Family Season Card

For an annual fee of \$55 (Which is in addition to the annual Homeowner's dues), a member may purchase a Family Season Card that will allow the member's family to use the facilities. *Corporations that own property are not eligible.* **Eligible family members are: parents, grandparents, non-dependent children, or grandchildren of the member.** The member does not have to accompany the family member to the facility, and need not sign-in such persons. However, an adult member must accompany children under the age of 14.

The Family Season Card is effective from Memorial Day through Labor Day 2008. Cards must be purchased prior to using the facilities and the member is required to provide the names of the eligible family members who expect to use the card. Family members are required to show identification, as this ID will be checked against the family members listed on the card before being allowed entry into the facilities. Additionally, a Family Member cardholder may bring guests. **Guest fees apply to all of those over the age of one year.**

Guests (With Guest Pass, not accompanied by Member)

Members may leave their Guest Card in their residence for non owner usage. Guests must show the BLSHA Guest Card along with photo ID at the Recreation Office window. Possessing the Guest Card and photo ID entitles the bearer to *purchase a card for daily or weekly entry.* The fees are based on a family unit, which includes a father, mother and dependent children. **Guest fees apply to all of those over the age of one year.**

Renter (Possesses verification card from realtor)

A renter is an individual or single family who has contracted a Blue Lake Springs home from a rental agency. The renter is entitled to use the Blue Lake Springs facilities provided they show the Blue Lake Springs Renters Guest Card with name, lot and unit number, along with photo ID. This card allows them entry after the daily or weekly fee has been paid. Weekly passes are from noon of purchase date until noon of the seventh day. All renters must check in at the Recreation Office. The fees are based on a family unit, which includes a father, mother and their dependent children. **Each additional family staying in the rental home must purchase their own pass.**

Associate Membership:

Multiple owners of a property are eligible to purchase an Associate Member Card to use the facility. The fee is 50% of the improved lot annual assessment fee.

Group rates:

Rates are now available for member-sponsored groups, for those who wish to accompany a group such as an organization, church or school group. The fee is \$4 per person. Advance registration and approval must be obtained from the General Manager.

Note: All check-in procedures and payment of fees always apply to Fly-in Lake and must be paid before using the Fly-in Lake facility.

Extension of Membership Privileges Clarified 2008

1. The Primary Membership is assigned to the deeded owner of record ("Member"), per lot, and is non-transferable.

1A. In cases where there is more than one deeded owner) excluding cases of joint tenancy and tenants-in common), the Primary Membership is assigned to the majority owner.

1Aa. If shares of deeded ownership are equal among controlling parties, the co-owner with an unexcelled share first named on the deed will be assigned the Primary Membership

1B. In cases where common multiple co-owners share the fee-titles of more than one lot, rule 1Aa may be waived to prevent one co-owner from being assigned more than one Primary Membership.

1C. Any and all deeded co-owners not designated as the Primary Member shall be entitled to purchase an Associate Membership on an annual basis. An Associate Membership shall be assigned to only one co-owner and is non-transferable among additional co-owners.

2. Membership privileges (Primary or Associate) extend to the named individual (owner or co-owner), their spouse or domestic partner, all unmarried children and other dependents of the aforementioned two adults so long as those children/dependents are themselves without dependents, and any other person that resides in the owner's permanent household.

2A. Any person to which Membership privileges do not extend as described in paragraph 2 may use BLSHA facilities as a Guest of a Member ("Guests"), so long as they are accompanied by a Member (as defined) or have in their possession a valid Guest Card and proper identification.

Extension of Membership (Cont'd)

2Aa. Guests not accompanied by a Member are required to pay then-current Guest Fees for use of the recreational facilities.

2Ab. A membership is entitled to accompany six guests without charge. If the aforementioned maximum of six free guests is exceeded, those guests will each be required to pay the current Guests Fees for use of the recreational facilities.

3. Long-term renters of Member's BLS improved property ("Tenants") shall be entitled to purchase a long-term Guest Pass, on an annual basis at the then-current fee, to allow use of the recreational facilities by all individuals with the Tenant's BLS household.

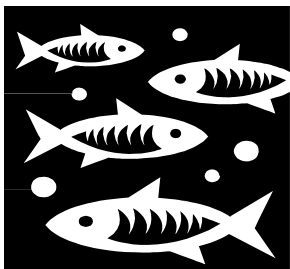
3A. Other individuals may accompany Tenants to BLSHA facilities, but the additional individuals (not members of the Tenant's BLS household) are subject to then-current Guest Fees.

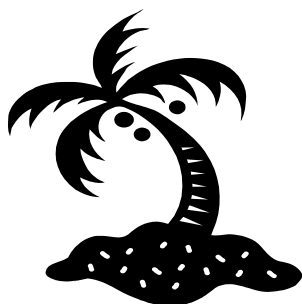

*Lodge Lake Fishing: Fish are planted in the lake shortly before the derby. **Open fishing is not permitted until after the derby on Saturday July 5.** The derby is from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. After the derby, fishing is allowed from dawn until 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. until dusk. Fishing is limited to ages 16 and under. Daily limit is five fish per person and you may fish until the lake is drained in the fall.

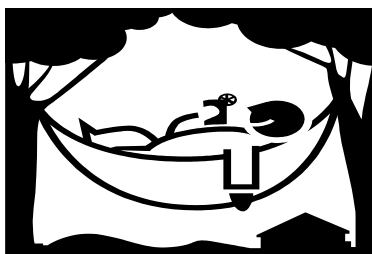

Students whose fee has not been paid prior to the class will be dropped to allow waitlist students admittance. During swim lessons we respectfully request that all parents and grandparents accompanying the student remain outside the pool enclosure. Thank you for your cooperation.***

Crafts for Children

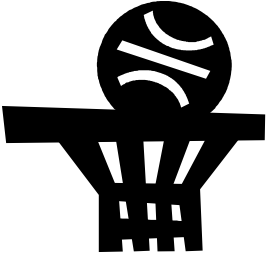

BLS Homeowners' Association Recreation Rules

(Please follow these rules for your safety)

- Members and guests must be in possession of their Blue Lake Springs identification card in order to use the facilities, this includes Fly-in Lake. Membership cards, along with photo ID, must be shown upon request.
- Members abusing the guest fee schedule may lose guest privileges.
- Use of the entire Blue Lake Springs facility is a privilege and management has the right to deny access due to inappropriate behavior. Profanity is not tolerated and is grounds for immediate ejection from the facility.
- The California State Health and Safety Code requires that an adult at least 18 years old must accompany children unable to swim and children under 14 years of age.
- Parents are responsible for the behavior and safety of their children at all times. (Even when there is lake personnel on duty)
- Glass containers of any kind are not allowed on the Blue Lake Springs premises, this includes the Lodge and all beach areas.
- All food and drinks must be consumed within the grass area or on the deck of the pool area.
- Swimmers must shower prior to entering the pool.
- Proper swimming attire is required; cut offs are not allowed.
- "Wake" boards are not permitted in the pool and the lifeguard has the right to disallow large toys when it has been determined it is an unsafe swimming condition.
- No running, pushing, diving or horseplay is allowed in or around the pool. No swinging on any of the safety rails, this includes the pool safety rail.
- Infants in the pool or lakes must wear tight fitting swim pants.
- When pool attendants are on duty, they will enforce the rules and take any action necessary to ensure the enjoyment and safety of members and guests.
- All MP3 players, radios and other musical devices must be used with ear plugs. Cooperation is mandatory.
- Members, or guests, are not permitted to use fireworks of any kind.
- No animals allowed in the Lodge area, pool or lake areas; except authorized companion dogs.
- Bicycles, skates, roller blades, skateboards, or scooters are not permitted on any of the Blue Lake Springs property; they may be confiscated if being used.
- Loitering in the parking lot is not permitted.
- Possession of alcoholic beverages by persons less than 21 years of age is prohibited.
- Smoking is not permitted inside the pool enclosure, tennis courts, basketball court or in the playground area. Tobacco products are not be used by anyone under the age of 18. Possession or use of illegal substances is not allowed or tolerated.
- Appropriate tennis shoes are required to play on the tennis courts.
- On special events and movie nights the facility is not open to other activities.
- Any ball playing needs to be played on the appropriate court. Football may be played on the grass by the lower tennis courts.
- The grounds and facility close at 10 p.m. unless there is a scheduled event. The lakes close at dusk.

Playground Rules

- The equipment manufacturer has designed this playground equipment for children nine and under. All those using the playground equipment do so at their own risk.
- For safety reasons, all children must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or guardian 18 years and older.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- The playground is open from 8 a.m. until dusk and is closed on all movie nights.
- Standing on the swings or on the playhouse roof is not permitted.
- No walking or running on the slide.
- Food or drinks are not allowed in the playground area.
- Equipment use is a privilege and management reserves the right to stop usage when rules are not obeyed.

Fly-in and Lodge Lakes

- Pushing and shoving is not allowed on any of the docks.
- No rock throwing.
- Rafts and other large floating devices are not allowed in the roped off or shallow areas of the lakes.
- Fires and BBQ's are not permitted on the beaches.
- Glass containers are forbidden on the beaches.

Members and guests using any of the Blue Lake Springs facility do so at their own risk. Neither the Association, nor its manager is responsible for injuries or accidents.
