Fly-In Lake Formally Open with Restrictions, Saturday, May 23rd

**BLUE LAKE SPRINGS HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION (BLSHA) FLY-IN LAKE USAGE
UNDER COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

BLSHA is following guidelines from the State and County health offices. The following usage restrictions will apply to all members using Fly-In Lake facilities. The guidelines are ever changing and BLSHA will make effort to update the membership as soon as possible.

- BLSHA will be limiting number of members using Fly-In Lake to 250.
- Once Fly-In Lake has reached the number capacity, both parking lots at the lake will be closed until the maximum capacity has dropped to allow more members access.
- Members must have their members card with the current year sticker and a photo ID in order to use Fly-In Lake.
- Members will be given a Waiver of Liability form to sign when checking in. This form will be kept on file and is valid for the summer season.
- Members are asked to adhere to social distancing requirements of six (6) feet and no more than ten (10) people within a household.
- The Association encourages members to bring their own recreation equipment (horseshoes, volleyball, etc.).
- There are no pets allowed, other than a service animal. A service animal is defined as an animal that are individually trained to do work or perform tasks for people with a disability.
- Members are advised to wear a mask when not in a family/household.
- Due to the State and Local Mandates Snowflake Lodge facilities is currently closed. The administration office is open for questions via phone or email.
